### **Friday, August 26 - Pool Play.**

Everyone will play each team in their pool two out of three games. The first two games will be 25 point rally scoring with a cap of 27 points. The third game will be rally scoring to 15, no cap. Everyone will be expected to help with refereeing by providing 2 linesmen, 1 scorekeeper, and one person to operate the visible scoreboard. The times listed below are approximate. Games may start earlier than the scheduled time; be ready to play. The warm up for each team's first match will be 12 minutes; each team will receive 6 minutes on the net. (2) Record of games lost

\*If this results in one team being eliminated from the tie and the other two teams remain tied then the head to head results from the two tied teams will determine place finish.
